Charitable Interests – BIB Project

Using the pattern included in your kit...

- 1. Cut 2. 1 back and 1 front, they should be identical. Fold your fabric in half longwise and place the pattern on the fold. You can stack the fabric, pin it and cut with a rotary cutter or scissors.
- 2. Seam allowance is 3/8 inch for stitching around the bib.
- 3. After cutting, with RIGHT SIDES together, pin front and back together. Leaving a 4 inch opening on 1 side for turning.
- 4. After you finish sewing, clip curves at the neck edge for easier turning. Turn bib right-side out and press. Slip stitch the open edges together.
- 5. On the OUTSIDE, top-stitch 1/4" away from all edges.
- 6. Using 1, 2-inch piece of Velcro for each bib you complete, separate Velcro. On the INSIDE, stitch the fuzzy half of the Velcro to the right back opening edge along the solid lines noted on the pattern.
- 7. On the OUTSIDE. Stitch the loopy half of the Velcro to the LEFT back opening edge along the solid lines. Please be sure to stitch the Velcro securely.
- 8. And you are all finished. We are not washing the bibs before taking to the Pines as they will wash them prior to use.
