

November 7, 2020, Guild Meeting via ZOOM

The meeting was called to order by **President Linda Forry** at 10:00 am. We had two new members in attendance, Jane Warren and Kathy Lennox. Welcome to both ladies. There were 50 members present on ZOOM for our meeting.

Linda announced that our meeting would begin with our program speaker, Brandy Yingling. Brandy is the owner of Blue Heron Stitchery in Bluffton. She gave us a tour of her expansive shop and studio area, and showed us many of the fabric lines she carries in her shop, as well as the notions and patterns available to us. We are so fortunate to have several independent quilt shops in our area. Brandy mentioned that she will be initiating a machine embroidery club sometime next year, and that she loves it when customers bring show and tell items to the shop. Brandy began her quilting journey by taking a paper-piecing class at Granny's, taught by guild member **Judy Cain**. She later decided to open up her own quilt shop, which opened in early 2019.

The minutes from the October guild meeting were accepted as published in the newsletter. The treasurer's report was accepted as published in the newsletter, and will be filed for audit.

MRQ will be updating the membership renewal form on the website to include the option to pay via PayPal; that new form should be uploaded soon.

Julie Hiscox discussed our ongoing efforts to make and donate charity quilts during the COVID situation. It has come to our attention that the Pregnancy Center of the Lowcountry gives layettes to new moms in need, and would love baby quilts to add to their layettes. They can use as many as we are willing to donate, with a suggested size of 36×36 to 30×40 . This size is small enough that members should be able to quilt them on their domestic sewing machines. Completed quilts can be brought to Blue Heron Stitchery where Julie Hiscox and Eileen Keohane will coordinate their delivery. Julie is also contacting Bluffton police department as to their interest in taking some of our larger lap quilts to have on hand for emergency situations.

Nancy Vandenburg spoke on behalf of the quilt raffle committee about the distribution of raffle tickets for our raffle quilt. The top is currently being quilted by Lynn **O'Neal** and is almost complete. It will be raffled on May 1, 2021. The tickets were handed out at a drive-through event in the parking lot of Palmetto Electric Coop on November 7, and any member who did not receive their packet will be able to access them through a neighborhood representative. **Sylvia Cameron** will cover Sun City South, **Linda Forry** will cover Sun City North, **Debi Bacon** has tickets for The Haven, **Kristine Richardson** has tickets for the Beaufort area members. Money and ticket stubs must be returned by April 1, 2021.

Fran Oblander discussed upcoming programs, and announced that Gyleen Fitzgerald will be our program speaker at the December 5 meeting. **Cynthia Cassidy** is scheduled to bring us a demonstration of making freeform collage pillows at our January 9 meeting. The February program is planned to be a trunk show on the use of several Deb Tucker rulers. In March, **Linda Forry** will offer us a demonstration of an acrylic and fabric tool stand for our sewing area. The free pattern will be included. The newsletter will bring further information on these and other upcoming programs.

Minutes of November 7, 2020 Continued

Workshop news includes the upcoming "Cool Cars" workshop scheduled via Zoom on November 14, given by Andrea West. In December, Gyleen Fitzgerald will bring us her workshop entitled "Uptown", which will occur on December 5 and 6 via Facebook Live, with a rap-up session to be held on December 7. More information on these is available on the guild website. Several members confirmed that Facebook Live is very easy to use, and Gyleen will leave our group access up for several days so we can re-visit the page on our computers.

There has been a suggestion that the guild make Bosom Buddy protective seatbelt pads to give to chemo patients to protect their ports or tender surgical site areas. There is a free pattern available at Byannie.com. Members can download the pattern, which requires fat quarters and Soft and Stable foam to make. The local Breast Cancer centers will all accept as many of these as we can create. There was discussion on planning to have a workshop after Christmas to try making these.

Sharon Savastano and **Karla Ward** announced the winners of the five Birthday Bundles; the winners included **Fran Oblander, Julie Hiscox, Gaye Paquet, Sharon Savastano, and M.J. McConnell**. Sharon reminded us that Birthday Bundle information must be sent to her by November 21 in order to be uploaded for the December 5 meeting.

Linda Forry adjourned the meeting at 11:00.


