

Diana began quilting in 2014 when her husband bought her a sewing machine for Christmas. After taking a beginning quilting class her machine was never idle. She started taking more classes and learning as

a beginning quilting class her machine was never idle. She started taking more classes and learning as much as she could about precision piecing. In 2016 she was introduced to Studio 180 Design Tools through the Lemoyne Star tool and quickly bought up many of the other products in the line. Once she realized the precision they brought to her quilting, she set out to convert patterns to use the tools. In 2019 when she was at a retreat the owner of Wish Upon a Quilt in Raleigh, NC asked her to demo Lemoyne Star. Soon after she was teaching the tools at the shop. In February of 2020 she trained with Deb Tucker and her staff to become a Certified Instructor. Her enthusiasm for quilting, the Studio 180 method, and love of sharing her passion makes her a dynamic instructor. She teaches through Wish Upon a Quilt in Raleigh, NC. Since the pandemic started, she teaches over Zoom, allowing her to reach people out of her geographical area. Rose Parr—Healthy Quilting (www.healthyquilting.com)		
"Sew Smart - The Ergonomics of Healthy Quilting" is a live PowerPoint presentation that applies ergonomic theory to your crafting life. From cutting and sewing posture to stretches designed to be done at your sewing table. Strategies and tips are designed to "use what you have" to stay pain-free. Rose recommends viewing the program from your sewing space so that you can immediately relate to your own situation. She will answer questions about ergonomics and studio design at the end of her talk, and we can email her questions about personal modifications to stretches for up to 30 days after her talk.		
Rose holds professional certifications in Holistic Nutrition, Ergonomics, Personal Training, Home Economics, Reiki, and more. She says, "My ergonomic improvements / strategies are based on doc- umented research. The health and wellness information I present is selected specifically for the chronic conditions and common problem areas that makers encounter; it is based on health industry standards of practice and not on 'what worked for me.'"

Charitable Interests have accumulated 16 finished quilts to date. 8 are about lap size quilts and will be delivered to the Beaufort County Sheriff's office on Hilton Head Island on Thursday. The other 8 are baby to crib size and will be delivered to The Pregnancy Center of the Low Country on Hilton Head Island on Thursday.

We really appreciate all the donations for these organizations. The next donations of lap size quilts will be delivered to the Bluffton Police Department so we can ensure that all the organizations we contacted receive quilts as quickly as possible. Baby size quilts can be 36"-45" wide and 45"-54" long; lap size quilts should be 54"-60" wide and 68"-76" long. Or they can be dropped at Blue Heron Stitchery for us to pick up. We have people who are willing to do the quilting, binding and labeling if you don't want to do those yourself. January 9 2021, Guild Meeting via ZOOM

President **Linda Forry** opened the meeting at 10:00 via Zoom. We had 52 members present for today's meeting. Two new members have joined us, **Linda Hunt** (Lew) Johnson, and **Char Lane**. We welcome them into our group. At present, 81 members have renewed for the upcoming year.

The minutes from the December meeting were accepted as written in the January newsletter. The treasurer's report was accepted, and filed for audit.

Julie Hiscox, chair of the charitable interest committee, currently has 6 infant and 5 lap quilts that are completed. She will deliver the infant quilts to the Pregnancy Center this week. Now that the holiday season is behind us, we hope that all members will try to make a quilt for this effort. It is suggested that infant quilts be approximately 36×36 to 36×40 , and that lap quilts for the Bluffton Police Department, and Beaufort County Sheriff's Office, be approximately 48×60 . Linda Forry has some donated fabric for backings if needed. Debi Bacon has volunteered to quilt some quilt tops if needed.

Nancy Vandenberg, raffle quilt chair, announced that we still have raffle tickets available to sell. A picture of the finished quilt will be available for members soon. On March 6, there will be a drive-through event at Church of the Palms on Rt 170 to pick up additional raffle tickets, or to return money for tickets sold. The deadline to turn in money from raffle tickets is April 1. The drawing for the raffle quilt will be on May 1, 2021.

Fran Oblander gave us an update on upcoming programs from February through June. The newsletter and website will have more information posted on each program. **Fran** and **Lynn O'Neal** have been co-chairs of programs for this year, and their term of office is finished in June. Volunteers are needed to chair this very important committee going forward. Please contact any current board member to express your interest.

Linda Forry updated us on the Bosom Buddies project that the workshop committee is finalizing. She has made a couple of samples, and stated that the committee will be putting kits together and perhaps planning a workshop to make these. A walking foot and wonder clips would be very helpful for construction.

Sharon Savastano and **Karla Ward** are hopeful that all members will participate in donating a Birthday Bundle for our monthly fundraiser, as well as continuing to bid on the posted bundles. The deadline for sending them a photo of your Birthday Bundle for the February meeting is January 23.

Gaye Paquet confirmed that at the end of January a new membership directory will be compiled, and emailed to members who have paid 2021-22 dues. **Gaye** would like a photo for the directory from new members, as well as any members who aren't currently pictured in our directory.

Karla Ward announced that the winners of the January Birthday Bundles were **Julie Hiscox**, bundles 1,2,3, and 4. **Cindy Tracy** won birthday bundle #5.

Cynthia Cassidy provided our program, which was a demonstration of how she makes collage wall quilts. She quilts her pieces on her longarm, but they can be quilted on a domestic sewing machine also. She makes use of Pinterest for many collage ideas, and finds that kids coloring pages are a great option for simple shapes and templates from which to start a collage project. She did warn us that she often uses small scraps for her collages, and therefore now finds that no scrap is too small to be saved for this purpose. We all could be in trouble on this! Cynthia did a demo via Zoom, to show us how she constructs a face, with various features in traditional, or more contemporary, abstract ways. Another demo was of a school of fish, on a background that she pre-quilted with waves. Various eyes, fins and lips were added in a whimsical manner. The pieces can be stitched in place via a long-arm or sewing machine, with perhaps some Elmer's glue or Roxanne glue basting to fix small pieces in place. Thanks to Cynthia for a great program!

Linda Forry adjourned the meeting at 11:50 am.
