

## Maye River Quilters Guild

April 10, 2021, Guild Meeting via ZOOM

President **Linda Forry** opened the meeting at 10:00 am on Zoom. There were 44 members present, including new members **Judy Hertel**, **Judy Lanahan-Sneed**, and **Becky Robinson**. Becky is the owner of the soon to open quilt show Sew Suites Studio at 4375 Bluffton Parkway. She hopes to open in late April. Check out her website at sewsuitestudio.com for updates. Becky expects to be open Tuesdays through Saturdays, and her hours are being finalized now.

The minutes from the March guild meeting were approved as published in the April newsletter. The treasurer's report was accepted as published, and will be filed for audit.

**Linda** reminded us that ideas for our charitable interest project for the upcoming year are due on Friday, April 16. The board will review the ideas and present the options to the guild for a vote at the May meeting.

In preparation for our vote for the 2021-2022 new guild board members, Jean LeBlanc sent out three practice surveys. The question box appeared on our Zoom screen, with a choice to be made. Jean could see a total of votes submitted instantly, and she clarified that she only sees vote totals and cannot see how any member voted. After determining that the system was working and members could vote easily, we proceeded to present the slate of officers for the upcoming year. Forty out of the forty four members present voted, which was 93% of the members present. The vote was 100% in favor of the slate presented. The newly elected board is Fran Oblander- President, Gaye Paquet- Vice President, Julie Hiscox- Secretary, Jean Le-Blanc- Secretary, and Lill Helming- Member-at-Large. Congratulations; the current board thanks you for stepping up to lead us in the upcoming year. The new board will be sworn in at the May guild meeting.

**Debi Bacon** reported news concerning our guild quilt retreat. The October retreat at Epworth has been cancelled, and they will refund our deposit. The new quilt retreat will be at St. Christopher's on Seabrook Island, SC. It will be 3 pm on Friday, October 22 through 2 pm on Sunday, October 24. The May newsletter will have a signup form, and the meal plan is a la carte. You can decide which meals you would like to eat and pay for, however once you have sent in your deposit with those choices, you cannot make any changes to your meal choices.

**Linda Forry** reported that most raffle ticket stubs and cash have been returned, but we still have about 200 tickets available to sell. The drawing will be held on May 1.

Granny's Quilts and More has closed, as the building ownership has changed. Edie is searching for a new location in order to re-open. Edie donated about \$600 worth of fabric to the guild to be used for charity quilts. Several members have taken bundles, and **Linda Forry** has plenty more to distribute to any member interested.

**Fran Oblander** spoke about upcoming programs, and reminded us that the May program will be the induction of new officers and recognition awards. The June program will be a Zoom round-robin presentation, with several 10 minute tutorials.

**Eileen Keohane** reported that twelve baby quilts were presented in March to the Pregnancy Center of the Lowcountry for donation to low income moms-to-be. She is still collecting lap sized quilts for donation to the Bluffton Police Department.

**Karla Ward** thanked the members who donated items to be added to Birthday Bundles. She and **Sharon Savastano** are using the donations to enhance the Birthday Bundles given by members. She reminded us that this is a major fundraiser for the guild, and during the meeting break we can make one last bid on the current bundles.

Rose Parr, of Ontario, Canada, gave a very informative program via Zoom on how to set up our sewing area in a more ergonomic manner. She reminded the members that we all take good care of our various machines and equipment, but that it's most important that we maintain us!

Jean LeBlanc then broke the members out into 10 minute breakout rooms, where members could chat, discuss ideas for charity quilt projects for the upcoming year, and do a small show and tell. When we returned to the main session, Karla announced that Birthday Bundles were won by Linda Forry- twice, Julie Hiscox, Cindy Rosenberry, and Fran Oblander.

**Linda Forry** adjourned the meeting at 12:12 pm.
