October 3, 2020, Guild Meeting via ZOOM

President Linda Forry opened the Zoom meeting at 10:00 am. There were 39 members present, with no visitors.

Minutes from the September guild meeting were approved as published in the news-letter.

The treasurer's report was approved as published, and will be filed for audit. Linda reminded the membership to send photos of completed quilts to **Holly Martin**, who will add them to our website for virtual Show and Tell.

Linda Forry opened a discussion of proposed changes to our by-laws that the board of directors feels are necessary to address issues that have affected the guild's operation in the last couple of years. These proposed by-law changes were published in the October guild newsletter. We've dealt with several hurricanes, as well as a pandemic with lockdown. The lockdown prevented us from meeting in person in April 2020 to vote for incoming officers. Our original bylaws stated that we must vote in April, and install new officers at the May meeting. Our by-laws have no electronic voting option, but the state has some general rules for 501c3 organizations that includes procedure for emergency practices. Following those rules as best we could, our guild voted electronically in April, with good participation. Our proposed changes add these emergency contingency plans to our bylaws and spell out the rules by which we would proceed. The board is also proposing a change to our guild calendar year, to have our membership year coincide with our fiscal year. The proposal is for the upcoming membership year to begin January 1, 2021 and proceed to May 31, 2022. Dues would be \$42 for the 17 month period, and thereafter our year would begin June 1 and end the following year on May 31. This will make budget planning much easier as we will have a known income from memberships, and enable our committees to enlist the aid of members in a timely manner. After discussion, Debi Bacon made a motion to approve the bylaw changes, seconded by Fran Oblander. We voted on Zoom, via raised hands visually counted by the President. The vote was 39 in favor, none opposed. The bylaws were unanimously accepted.

Linda Forry reported that the raffle quilt is being quilted by **Lynn O'Neal** and should be ready soon. Photos of the quilt will be available once it is complete. The tickets have been printed, and will be \$1 each this year. The raffle committee of **Barbara Millsap, Susan Tyler, and Nancy Vandenberg** could use some help with distributing ticket packets to members. There will be a drive through pickup opportunity on November 7 at 1pm at the Palmetto Electric Cooperative parking lot. A second pickup is scheduled for December 12 at the same location.

Julie Hiscox and Eileen Keohane have distributed 20 charity quilts each to Mercy Mission and Bluffton Self-Help. At this time the state DSS is unable to accept quilts from us due to storage issues at their offices. The charity committee is working to identify other local charities that might have a use for our quilts. The committee is open to adapting our charity project for this year to include other projects. Debi Bacon had a suggestion to make pillowcases filled with personal care items for the SS Johnson, based in Charleston. The board and charity committee will discuss this in the coming weeks.

Sharon Savastano reminded the members to send a picture of your November birthday bundle to either Karla Ward or **Sharon Savastano** by October 23 so that it can be posted for bidding.

Minutes of October 2, 2020 Continued

Sandy Graves announced that the November 14 workshop, Cool Cars, scheduled on Zoom with Andrea West, has 17 registered participants. The Gyleen Fitzgerald workshop in December will be held via Facebook Live and will be broken into 3 days. It will occur on December 5, 6 and 7 with two teaching sessions, and a wrap-up. Participants will have access to a Facebook Live page for about 30 days afterward to communicate with each other, or Gyleen. Check the MRQ website for further information. Signup for the workshop is available now, and PayPal is now available for members to pay if they wish. You do not need a PayPal account to use this function, you may use a credit card for payment. Checks can also be mailed with the registration form.

Our October program was a great presentation from Beth Ritter, who owns Island Quilters shop on Hilton Head. She shared with us many seasonal project ideas from her shop, as well as special Hilton Head Island batik fabrics that are custom designed. There were plenty of ideas to keep us entertained while we're at home.

Our November program will include a presentation by Brandy Yingling, owner of Blue Heron Stitchery in Bluffton. Brandy will discuss current trends in the quilt industry.

Birthday bundle winners were announced, and the winners include Gaye Paquet, Sandra Walsh, and Linda Forry.

Linda Forry adjourned the meeting at 11:15 am.
