September 12, 2020, Guild Meeting via ZOOM

**President Linda Forry** convened the meeting at 9:30 on Zoom. The earlier start time was due to having our presenter, Andrea West, give us a short program prior to the start of her Zoom workshop following the meeting. We had one visitor, Kathy Lennox, who is an active quilter living in Sun City.

The minutes from the August 1 guild meeting were accepted as published in the newsletter. **Jean LeBlanc** had a correction to the treasurer's report, and amended it to correct the July membership income to be \$30 instead of \$90. The amended report will be filed for audit.

**Debi Bacon** announced that she and **Ann Godwin**, our guild founders, have decided to award their annual Founders Award to *Holly Martin* in recognition of her extensive work to get our website up and running this year. Congratulations to Holly!

The speaker for the October Zoom meeting will be Beth Ritter, owner of Island Quilters. She will be sharing with us new trends in the industry. November will bring us Brandy Yingling, owner of Blue Heron Stitchery, who will also share updates on quilting news. Fran Oblander will be sending Holly information on our upcoming monthly Zoom meetings that will be posted on the MRQ website for all to see.

**Linda Forry** announced that members seeking addresses or phone numbers from the members directory should not use the February version of the roster, as there are numerous incorrect or missing items. All members are asked to check the July members directory to assure that their information is correct, and use this version for information.

**Linda Forry** has added MRQ to the SC Quilt Guild website directory, so we will be visible to those looking for a guild in the area.

**Gaye Paquet** reminded all officers and committee chairs that the deadline for items to be published in the monthly newsletter is the 17th of the month. The guild newsletter is an important lifeline to us all as we continue to run our guild remotely while we await the time when we can meet again in person.

**Sharon Savastano** reported that September 19 is the deadline to submit Birthday Bundles for the October 3 meeting. Bidding will begin 5 days before the meeting on the MRQ website. Sharon will pick up the bundle from the donor and deliver it to the winner, where she will collect the payment check on delivery.

**Linda Forry** asked that we all read the proposed bylaw changes that were published in the newsletter. There are three different sections needed to address different issues. She explained that the board wishes to change the start of our membership year to begin June 1, in tandem with our fiscal year. More discussion will occur at our October 3 guild meeting

Julie Hiscox reported that we have begun distributing the available small quilts to two local agencies for distribution. Julie delivered 19 quilts with some totes and toiletry bags to Mercy Mission in Hardeeville. Eileen Keohane will be delivering 20 additional quilts to Bluffton Self Help. At this time the state DSS is unable to accept quilts due to the covid pandemic; their storage facilities are in use to store PPE. We will revisit their readiness to take quilts for their kinship program later in the fall. In the meantime we have found local social agencies that are happy to receive our quilts.

**Lynn O'Neal** introduced Andrea West as our speaker. Andrea is certified through the Sew Kind of Wonderful Ruler Company to teach their patterns, using their rulers, for easier curved piecing. Andrea showed us several quilt samples that she teaches, including the Chic Picnic quilt scheduled following today's meeting and the Cool Cars workshop scheduled November 14.

Karla Ward announced the winners of the birthday bundles, who included Sandra Walsh, Gaye Paquet, Debi Bacon and Jean LeBlanc.

**Linda Forry** adjourned the meeting at 10:05. Andrea West's Zoom workshop was scheduled to follow with 20 participants.

#### Note from Our Treasurer-Jean LeBlanc

Gammill Vision 2 18" throat (13.5" quilting area) on a 12' home pro frame. Very well maintained and clean. This is a perfect machine for the first time longarmer whether wanting to quilt hand guided, free motion or to use paper panto graphs to do personal quilts, although many use this machine to quilt for others as the 12' frame will handle a king sized quilt.

Aside from the included base items, I have upgraded to swivel casters (\$149) for easier moving. Also included is a stand alone bobbin winder (\$150), ruler base plate, panto designs, quilt clips (\$49), a starter supply of bobbins, needles, spools of thread, as well as a few maintenance extras such as anti-backlash bobbin spring, and oil (prices listed are included in the total asking price).
