## Maye River Quilters Guild August 1, 2020, Guild Meeting via ZOOM

The meeting was called to order on ZOOM by **President Linda Forry** at 10:00 am. There were no new members present, and at peak there were 47 members present plus our program speaker, Donna Royson.

The minutes from the July 11 meeting were approved as published. The Treasurer's Report was accepted as written and will be filed for audit.

Linda Forry reminded us that birthday bundles are on our guild website. Please check the website and newsletter for updated information. Our thanks to Gaye Paquet and Holly Martin for keeping the information current. If any member has information that needs to be published in our newsletter, Gaye's deadline is the 17th of the month in order for our newsletter to reach our members a week before our next meeting.

The Palmetto Quilt Guild is sponsoring a Zoom workshop on Friday, October 16 from 9-3:30 featuring Becky Goldsmith teaching her applique technique. They have invited members of our guild to join in, and the cost is \$45. Registration for the workshop entitles us to attend their guild meeting on Thursday, October 15 from 1-3.

Julie Hiscox, chair of the Charity Committee, reported that there are 40 small quilts being stored at Blue Heron Stitchery that are available for donation. Julie and Eileen Keohane are attaching labels as needed, and Julie is working to create a list of sites that can accept donations at this time. More tote bags and toiletry bags will be needed to accompany these quilts.

Sharon Savastano and Karla Ward reported on Fundraising committee news. They asked members to create a birthday bundle to donate on their birthday month. Please take a picture and write a brief description which must be sent to Sharon or Karla 15 days before the next guild meeting. This gives Holly Martin time to upload the information to our website. Birthday Bundles will be posted 7 days ahead of a meeting, and they can be bid upon until bidding closes at the meeting. Winners will be announced at the end of our Zoom meeting.

Judy Cain and Joanne Moss are busy completing our raffle quilt. Lynn O'Neal has generously offered to longarm quilt it, and raffle tickets will be available soon.

Debi Bacon has been coordinating our upcoming retreat at Epworth on October 9-11. She was in need of two more participants in order to go. At the meeting, two additional members agreed to join the group, so the retreat at Epworth on St. Simons Island, GA is on! Have fun, ladies.

Our September Zoom meeting will begin earlier than usual, at 9:30 on Saturday, September 12. Andrea West will give us a demonstration of her Quick Curve Ruler. After the meeting concludes about 10:15, Andrea will be teaching a Zoom Workshop called Chic Picnic, which uses this ruler. Sandy Graves from Workshop Committee reported that 20 members have signed up for this workshop, which will require a separate sign-in on Zoom in order to attend.

Karla Ward requested that we all look at our own entry in the MRQ directory. Please check your phone number, which may need updating. The Fundraising Committee has discovered that when trying to contact Birthday Bundles bid winners, some phone numbers are incorrect. Please contact Gaye Paquet with updates, as she keeps the directory current.

Fran Oblander, as co-chair of the Programs committee with Lynn O'Neal, introduced our speaker for the August meeting. Donna Royson presented a great program about Eleanor Burns and her Quilt In A Day teaching program. Donna has been a certified instructor for a number of years. She has created a Zoom teaching program with great power-point slides to explain how to make several quilts using Eleanor's techniques. I think we all saw a few quilts we might need to add to our project lists. During her program, Donna gave out several patterns as prizes, and one lucky member, Joyce Haskins, received a full kit of an Eleanor Burns project. Donna also mentioned that on the Quilt In A Day website, there are videos explaining how to make many of Eleanor's quilts. Donna is selling patterns and rulers from Quilt In A Day, and giving MRQ members a discount until August 24. There is an order form on our website. Items ordered will be sent to the Program chairs, who will coordinate the delivery to members.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 am.

Many people have finished and gifted their quilts, but Kristine doesn't want to leave anyone hanging.


